VP Richardson moved, seconded by Member Holland to re-elect Darren Houk as President and to elect Raul Sanchez as Vice-President. All voted "Aye".

8. CONSIDER APPROVAL OF 4RD QUARTER FY 2024 E.D.C. FINANCIAL REPORT (APRIL 1 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024).

CM Gregory reported the beginning balance for the 3rd quarter was \$317,553.08; sales tax for the quarter totaled \$78,284.16; interest from the bank was \$42.43; resulting in total revenues of \$78,326.59. Total expenditures for the quarter of \$20,859.32-yielding an ending balance of \$375,020.35. Texpool beginning balance was \$288,820.88; interest received was \$3,843.51-resulting in an ending balance of \$292,664.39. Total ending balance in the bank and Texpool is \$667,684.74.

Member Holland moved, seconded by Member Chisholm to approve the FY 2024 Third Quarter Financial Report. All voted "Aye".

9. UPDATE FROM PRESIDENT HOUK REGARDING NEW BUSINESSES OR PROPERTIES FOR SALE OR LEASE.

The chiropractic building on Roberts Cut Off is still for sale. The building at Merritt and the Blvd property was for lease but the sign is gone. A & A Motors has an offer. The two acres that is next to A & A Motors that is residential just sold. Boston Lane development has sold to Ashland Homes.

## 11. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT:

Met with Placer.ai. Their software is a good tool for development, but the costs is \$14,000.00 to \$17,000.00 a year. They are scheduled to give a presentation on August 12<sup>th</sup>, but the board agreed to cancel the presentation.

The fireworks show was good but there were delays in between shots. Victory Church donated \$3,500.00 towards the fireworks. The July 4<sup>th</sup> event at the Event Center, did not have a good turnout.

Big Grant-Faded Art has completed their project and was reimbursed \$2,000.00. Italiano's has signed their agreement and their sign has been ordered.
