Oncor will not bill customers, so do not pay anyone who claims to be collecting money on behalf of Oncor.

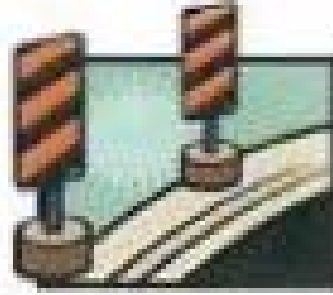
It's not uncommon for scam attempts to increase in the aftermath of severe storms.

Dear Resident,

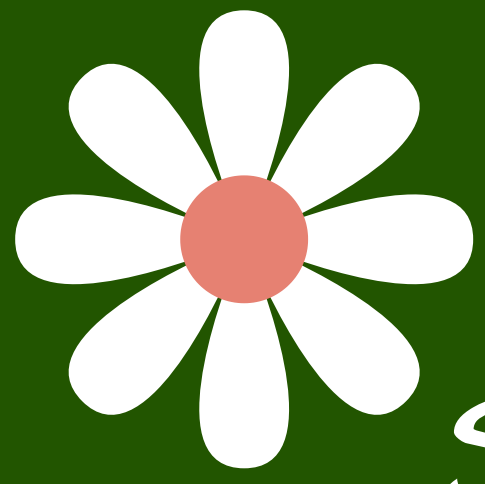

Trash service will not be affected.

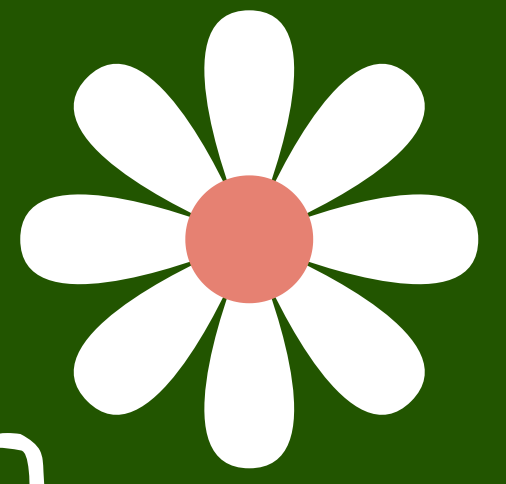

You must have an active water account, in good standing, at the yard sale address.

You must also provide a valid United States-issued photo ID with the yard sale address on it.
