PEDIATRIC MOBILE CLINIC

The Pediatric Mobile Clinic will provide dental checkups and fluoride applications. All children 0-18 are eligible.

For children without insurance, or that receive Medicaid benefits, the Pediatric Mobile Clinic will also offer:

- 6th Grade Vaccines (11-12 year olds) TDAP, Meningitis (MCV4), and HPV
- Flu Vaccines (0-18 year olds)

Please bring a copy of your child's vaccination record if possible. *Please note children covered by CHIP or private insurance are not eligible to receive vaccines.*
