“Press Release”

The City of River Oaks will commence construction on May 7, 2018 for major improvements on their sanitary sewer collection system. These improvements will address the replacement of the existing old sanitary sewer collection lines throughout the City. This first phase of construction will consist of approximately 2,246 linear feet of 12 inch diameter sewer lines, 37,353 linear feet of 8 inch diameter sewer line, 661 individual sewer services and 113 individual sewer manholes. These improvements will replace old sanitary sewer lines that are a continuous source of pollution caused by sewage stoppages. Extensive maintenance problems and costs will be greatly reduced upon these improvements being completed. These improvements will greatly enhance service to the citizens of River Oaks and eliminate the potential sources of pollution that presently exists within the sanitary sewer collection system. These improvements are wholly funded through the EPA, under the Clear Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) program as administered by the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB).
