To: All River Oaks Water Customers

RE: Processing Fees

Please be advised that the City Council approved the City's Fiscal Year 2026 Budget on September 2, 2025 that will start on October 1, 2025 and end on September 30, 2026 and with its adoption as of October 1, 2025, the City of River Oaks will no longer pay the 3.7% processing fee for payments made through My Civic Utilities Mobile App and the Municipal On-line Payments Website meaning those that pay their bills through the app or website will be responsible as of October 1, 2025 to pay the 3.7% processing fee, whereas before the City absorbed the fees at no cost to the customer.

The good news out of all of this is that the City Council approved the Budget for Fiscal Year 2026 on September 2, 2025 with no water or sewer rate increase this year. All the amenities that you have enjoyed over the last year using My Civic Utilities Mobile App and the Municipal On-line Payments website will still be available as before including auto pay, view bill and Quick Pay. The only thing changing is the processing fee will be charged to the customer.

To avoid processing fees, you can pay your bill in person by cash, check or money order in the City Hall located at 4900 River Oaks Blvd in River Oaks, Texas. You can also use our after-hours night drop box to pay your bill payments after normal business hours.

We do apologize for any inconvenience this may cause you, but just know we are constantly working to achieve the ultimate goal in providing our customers with quality utility services at the best rate possible. 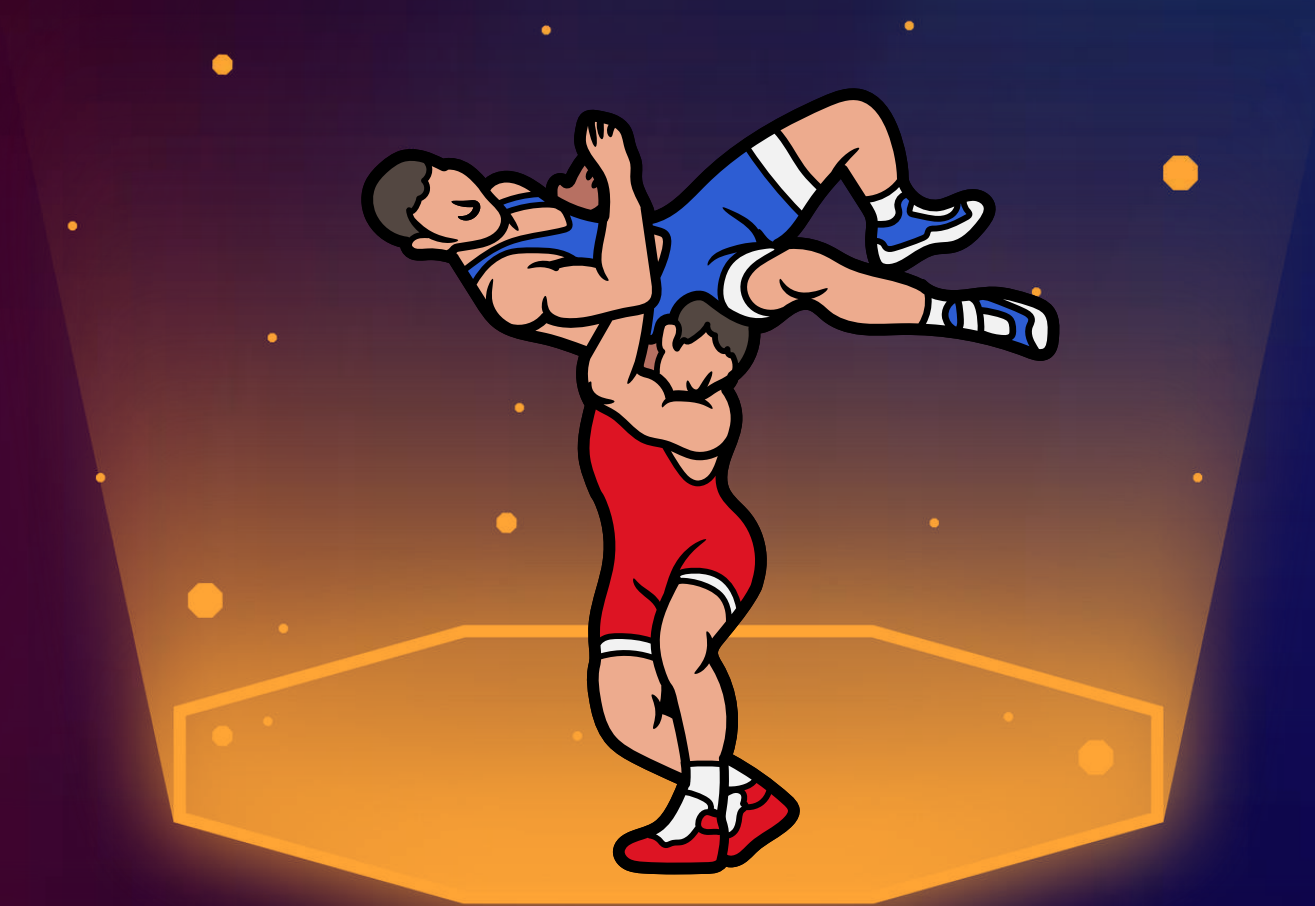

YARD SALES

You may have 2 yard sales in a row, skip a week, then have 2 more for a total of 4 yard sales per year.

Yard sale permits are \$10 each. This allows you 1 permit sign and 2 directional signs. You may purchase up to 3 additional directional signs at \$1 each. Signs must be picked up within 24 hours of the end of sale or fines may be issued. You must have an active water account, in good standing, at the yard sale address. You must also provide a valid United States-issued photo ID with the yard sale address on the ID and the Yard Sale Permit must be purchased 24 hours before the sale. To have your Yard Sale placed in the weekly Newsletter, you must have purchased your Yard Sale Permit prior to 4:30 pm on Thursday the week of your sale.
