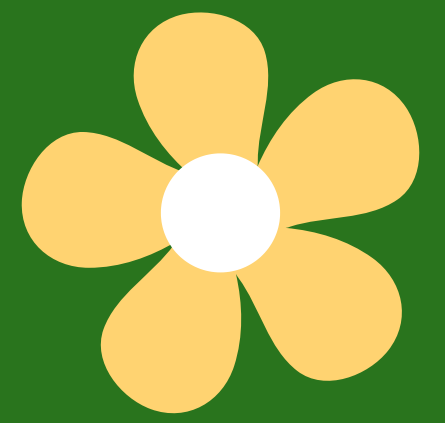
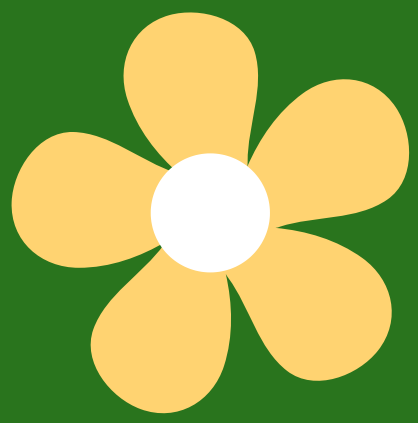
FREE - NO PERMIT REQUIRED!

The use of your own signs is permitted on your property ONLY!

Per Ordinance: You must be on the water account and you must provide an ID with matching address of the property. No signs are allowed to be placed on the boulevard, or on street signs, stop signs, utility poles or any structure owned by the City. You must pick up your yard sale signs within 24 hours of the end of this event.

Please come to City Hall by March 19th @ 4:00 pm to register your address to be placed on the Yard Sale List and to pick up your 2 free signs!

River Oaks Food Bank

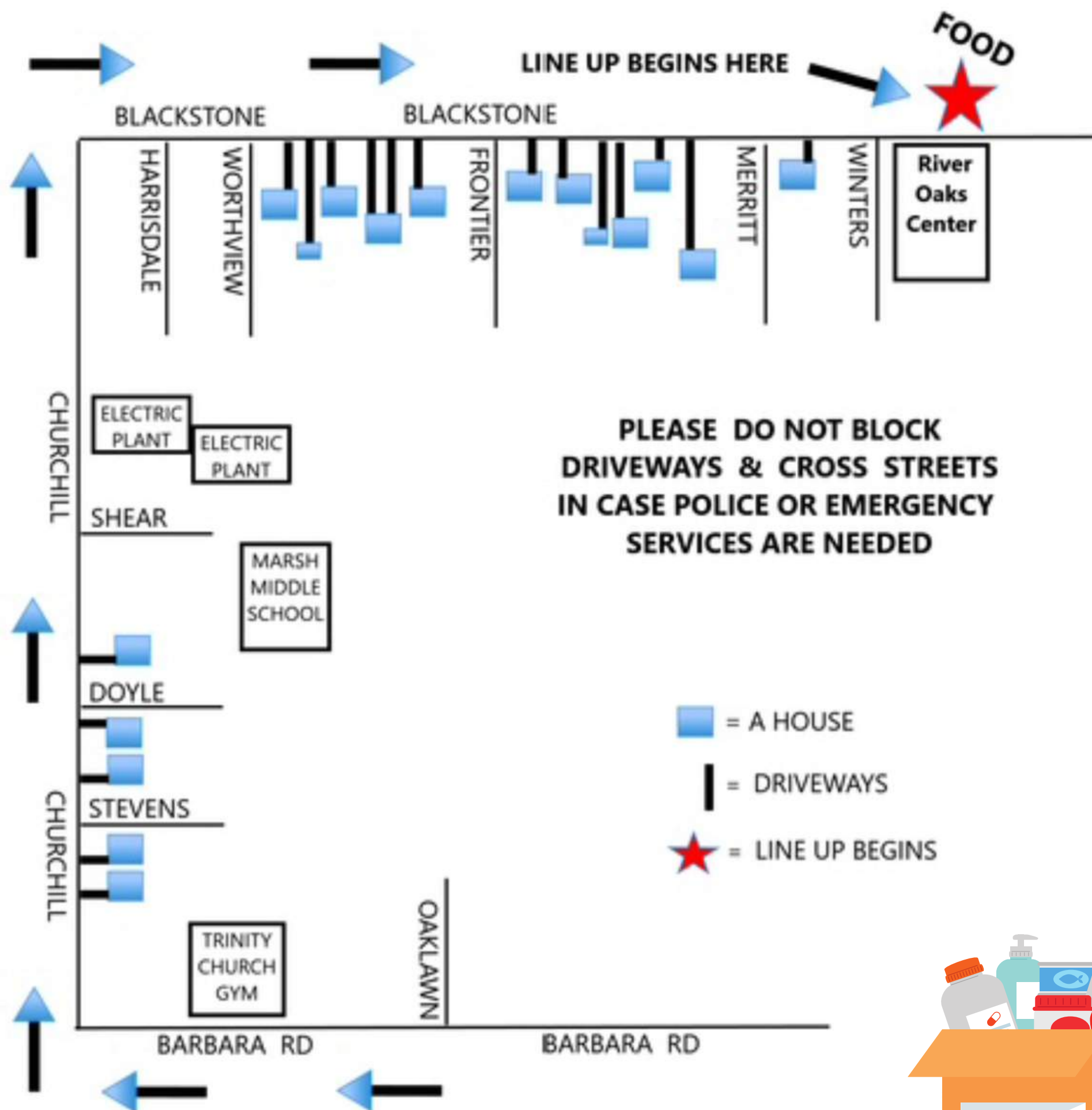
Our Food Banks are held the 2nd and 4th

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YARD SALES

You may have 2 yard sales in a row, skip a week, then have 2 more for a total of 4 yard sales per year. Yard sale permits are \$10 each. This allows you 1 permit sign and 2 directional signs. You may purchase up to 3 additional directional signs at \$1 each. Signs must be picked up within 24 hours of the end of sale or fines may be issued. You must have an active water account, in good standing, at the yard sale address. You must also provide a valid United States-issued photo ID with the yard sale address on the ID and the Yard Sale Permit must be purchased 24 hours before the sale. To have your Yard Sale placed in the weekly Newsletter, you must have purchased your Yard Sale Permit prior to 4:30 pm on Thursday the week of your sale.
