
What Is Accepted?

What Is Not Accepted?

Ammunition & Explosives Appliances & Electronics Building Materials Bulk Trash & Yard Waste Butane/Propane Cylinders Medical Waste Asbestos/PCBs/ Radioactive Material

Leave products in original, marked containers (no trash bags). If unlabeled, please label contents. DO NOT transport chemicals in the passenger compartment of your vehicle. Place items securely in the trunk of your car or truck bed.

Our Food Banks are held the 2nd and 4th Fridays of each month. River Oaks Event Center 5300 Blackstone Drive River Oaks, TX, 76114


You are encouraged to begin lining up by 8:30 AM to get a good place in line.

YARD SALES

You may have 2 yard sales in a row, skip a week, then have 2 more for a total of 4 yard sales per year. Yard sale permits are \$10 each. This allows you 1 permit sign and 2 directional signs. You must have an active water account, in good standing, at the yard sale address. You must also provide a valid United States-issued photo ID with the yard sale address on the ID and the Yard Sale Permit must be purchased 24 hours before the sale. To have your Yard Sale placed in the weekly Newsletter, you must have purchased your Yard Sale Permit prior to the close of the previous business day as the Newsletter is posted on Friday mornings.
