WINTER WEATHER

COLDER TEMPERATURES WILL SOON BE HERE SO NOW IS THE TIME TO PREPARE:

- DISCONNECT ALL HOSES AND INSULATE OUTSIDE FAUCETS. FOAM FAUCET COVERS ARE INEXPENSIVE AND VERY EASY TO INSTALL. THEY COME FULLY ASSEMBLED AND CAN BE REUSED EACH SEASON.
- INSULATE WATER PIPES. CHECK AREAS OF THE HOME WHERE PIPES ARE PRONE TO FREEZING SUCH AS A BATHROOM THAT HAS AN OUTSIDE WALL, CRAWL SPACES, ATTICS, AND GARAGES. USE FOAM PIPE INSULATION OR INSULATING TAPE TO COVER THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF THE EXPOSED PIPE.
 - · KEEP THE COLD OUT. BOOST YOUR HOME'S ABILITY TO HOLD IN HEAT BY APPLYING WEATHER STRIPPING AROUND DOORS AND WINDOWS OR INSTALL A PLASTIC WINDOW INSULATION K
- TAKE CARE OF OUTDOOR PETS BY BUYING A HEATED WATER BOWL FOR DOGS OR INSTALLING A HEATING ELEMENT IN YOUR CERAMIC BIRDBATH. BRING OUTSIDE PETS IN WHEN TEMPERATURES DROP BELOW FREEZING.
 - STOCK UP. PURCHASE IN ADVANCE ALL THE NECESSARY TOOLS TO CLEAR SIDEWALKS AND DRIVEWAYS SUCH AS SNOW SHOVELS, SALT OR SAND, AND WINDSHIELD DEICER.
 - CREATE AN EMERGENCY KIT. IN CASE THE POWER GOES OUT, OR YOU ARE UNABLE TO LEAVE YOUR HOME, PREPARE AN EMERGENCY KIT WITH ITEMS SUCH AS A BATTERY-POWERED RADIO, CELL PHONE CHARGING BRICK, FLASHLIGHTS, EXTRA BATTERIES, CANDLES, AND MATCHES.

You are encouraged to begin lining up by 8:30 AM to get a good place in line.


Most of the time, the food supply truck arrives early, meaning food is given out sooner.

YARD SALES

You may have 2 yard sales in a row, skip a week, then have 2 more for a total of 4 yard sales per year. Yard sale permits are \$10 each. This allows you 1 permit sign and 2 directional signs. You must have an active water account, in good standing, at the yard sale address. You must also provide a valid United States-issued photo ID with the yard sale address on the ID and the Yard Sale Permit must be purchased 24 hours before the sale. To have your Yard Sale placed in the weekly Newsletter, you must have purchased your Yard Sale Permit prior to the close of the previous business day as the Newsletter is posted on Friday mornings.
